Parasha tidbits from the Rabbi

"וַּיָבָא הַבַּיְתָה לְּעְשִׂוֹת מְלַאכְתִּוֹ" (Beresheet 39:11) "...he went into the house to do his work..." Targum Onkelos translates this phrase as: "למבדק בכתבי חושבנה" — "to examine the records of the accounts." Even when Yosef was in the house of Potiphar and occupied with calculations and major business affairs, he nonetheless maintained the same devotion and self-nullification to G-d. It is in this that the greatness of Yosef's spiritual level is expressed: that he was able to hold on to his absolute attachment to the Holy One, even while being fully engaged with the practical matters of the world. Yosef HaTzaddik remained constantly steadfast in his connection to the Almighty throughout his life. May the example he set for us throughout the ages be a beacon of light, inspiring us always to place our trust in HaShem.
