Parasha tidbits from the Rabbi

"תִּמְחָה אֶת-זֵכֶר עַמְלִיק מִתַּחַת הַשָּׁמַיִם לֹא תִשְׁכַּח..." (Devarim 25:19) "...You shall blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven; you shall not forget." The Rebbe explains: Amalek came to battle the Children of Israel — specifically, "בדרך בצאתכם ממצרים" — on their way out of Egypt, on their way to receive the Torah. From this, Amalek's war is understood as being directed against the spiritual renewal that was to take place at Mount Sinai. It is well known that the giving of the Torah brought with it a universal and eternal message. Amalek opposes this message. Amalek represents separation — spirituality made secondary to materialism. Everyday life for all, Torah for none. Therefore, we are commanded to remember Amalek — their complete evil — so that we do not allow this mindset to reenter the human heart: the separation of the earthly from the Divine. A Jew must always remember that the holy Torah encompasses every aspect of life and every situation. We are living in a time when evil nations attempt to emulate Amalek. Yet we continue to witness the wonders of the Almighty G-d protecting His people — the very nation that received His Torah. שבת שלום ומבורך / Shabbat Shalom!
