### Parasha tidbits from the Rabbi

"וַיֵּלֶךְ מֹשֶׁה ... אֶל-כָּל-יִשְׂרָאֵל" (Devarim 31:1) "And Moshe went.... to all of Israel" The Lubavitcher Rebbe cites the following idea: It is easy to imagine the exalted and lofty spiritual level that **Moshe Rabbeinu** had reached after 120 years of serving G-d. And yet — how did he spend his final day? With "Vayelech" — with movement, with walking — continuing to ascend to an even higher level. *The Ma'ayanah Shel Torah* asks: What is meant by "Vayelech"? Where did Moshe go? The answer: To all of Israel. Moshe Rabbeinu entered into the very essence of every single Jew — for within each of us, there exists a spark of Moshe. Thus, "Moshe went to all of Israel." As we approach the **Day of Atonement — Yom Kippur**, let that spark of Moshe within each of us inspire and motivate all our efforts in doing **teshuvah**.
